Sample Word Bank cards

Below are four “sample cards” to give you an idea of what we are thinking of.

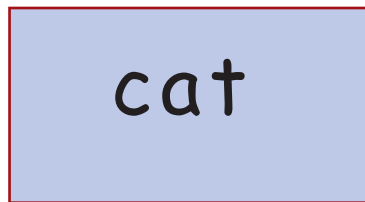
Here are some ideas for illustrations:

- * Your child can use clip art from your home computer (as we have)
- * He can draw his own illustrations
- * He can cut and paste magazine clippings for illustrations (works especially well for household items, like foods, household cleaners, tools, etc.) Use the Sunday sale papers and ads!

Remember, he doesn't *need* to use illustrations at all!

Below, we've done some color coding to show words *functioning* as parts of speech in sentences. Displayed are the fronts and backs of each card, side by side.

- * Blue is for words functioning as nouns.
- * Red is for words functioning as verbs.



For this card, there are at least two functions possible. Thus, the card has two illustrations and two colored dots on a white card. Alternately, the child could make two cards, a red and a blue, with illustrations appropriate to each.
